## About Us

In 1968, the school was started in a small way and formally founded in November 1970 by Late Dr (Mrs.) Kamala Ghosh in a rented premises in Jodhpur Park. Mrs. Kamala Ghosh was a doctorate from Sheffields, U.K. While she was abroad, a little child lovingly called her Auntie Edith. She named the school Auntie Edith's School in memory of that little girl. It began with a few students and a band of committed teachers. Later it was renamed in memory of her Late husband Mr.A.K.Ghosh who was the Founder Secretary of the school. A co-educational English Medium Kindergarten and Primary School which grew from strength to strength into a Junior High and then a High School. In 1999, it became a Higher Secondary School. It sent out its first School Final batch in 1977. The success rate was 100% and no one got below second division. In the same year, the school was shifted to its own building in the present premises. It is now a large family comprising more than 2000 students, 55 teachers and 27 non teaching staff members. The bonding between staff and students are very informal and personal excellence is the buzz word . We aspire to build a chain of schools, the first of which we opened on 14 Jan'14 at Batanagar, Maheshtala

# General Discipline

- ✓ Regular attendance and punctuality are a must. Late comers will be sent back to home.
- ✓ Students must wear a clean and proper school uniform
- ✓ Students are not allowed to attend when ailing or suffering from infectious disease.
- ✓ Students must complete their home-work regularly.
- ✓ Students are expected to behave in a proper and polite manner.
- ✓ No student is allowed to leave the school premises earlier than the scheduled leaving hours.
- ✓ No book, magazine or newspaper of objectionable nature can be brought to school.
- ✓ Students are not allowed to wear watches / gold jewellery to school.
- ✓ Any change in address / phone number must be reported to the school office for necessary change in records.
- ✓ Student must bring their own Tiffin in a proper Tiffin box. No food packets are allowed.
- ✓ Girls from Classes I - V must wear black rubber bands or hair bands. Coloured bands are not allowed.
- ✓ Plastic water bottles without straps are not allowed.
- ✓ Strict disciplinary action will be taken against any pupil who fights and causes injury to other pupils.
- ✓ Bus service is available.
- ✓ Children are not allowed to put stickers on books and copies.

# Absence

- Pupils absent from school must produce a letter explaining the cause of absence .
- A formal letter with a medical certificate is necessary in case of sickness for over three days.
- In case of ailment during half yearly or annual examination, guardians are to see the principal (during visiting hours only) with leave application and necessary medical certificate.
